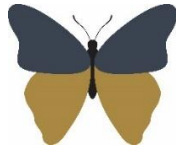

UNDERSTANDING YOUR CHILD GROUP

This group is co-facilitated with We Are With You and the group is aimed at parents/carers who need support with parenting and alcohol or drug misuse are a challenge. This group is a pilot and has come from feedback that parents/carers would like to be in a group setting where their challenges are understood. This group runs for 10 weeks from the start date excluding the School Holidays. The group starts on Wednesday 18th January 2023 in Shrewsbury from 10.00am to 12.00pm

ME MY CHILD & DOMESTIC ABUSE GROUP

This group is co-facilitated with Shropshire Domestic Abuse Service. The group is aimed at female survivors of domestic abuse who would like to understand more about the impact on their children's development and behaviour and how they can support their children's needs and development. This group runs for 11 weeks from the start date excluding the School Holidays. The group starts on Thursday 12th January 2023 in Shrewsbury from 10.00am to 12.00pm

SLEEP TIGHT WORKSHOP
